SENIOR & OVER 35'S "5-A-SIDE"

Centenary Stormers Football Club will be hosting a Seniors/Metro and over 35's "5-a-side" football tournament on Saturday the 11th July 2009 to help raise funds for our U11 squad that is travelling to Canberra in July for the Kanga Cup.

We invite all clubs in the open age group (Seniors/Metro & Over 35's) to enter teams into this tournament.

All games will be held at our home fields (Atthows Park, Westcombe Street in Darra *UBD - Pg 197 Q11*). The team registration table will be open from 10:00am - 10:30am and the managers & coaches briefing will be at 10:30pm with the first games kicking off at 11:00am sharp.

The tournament format will have 8 teams in each league. The seniors and over 35's leagues will be divided into to 2 groups of 4 teams. Each team will compete in a round-robin preliminary league (3 league games per team) with the 2 top teams from each league going through to a sudden death knockout finals play-off system. All players will each pay a **\$20** nomination fee which must be collected by the manager and paid by Wednesday the 8th July 2009 with team nomination form. **Please note a max of 8 players per squad** with only 5 players including the goal keeper allowed per game with unlimited interchanges.

- The winning team in each age group of the grand final will get gold medals.
- Runner-ups will receive silver medals.
- Hot food & Soft Drinks on sale all day
- Great family day

All places will be filled on a first paid, first registered basis.
Get in early to avoid disappointment !!!

Each team entered must send in its own nomination form with entry fee !!

Team Nomination forms and monies can also be handed into Jan at the Canteen or given directly to Lee Forrest

Tournament Rules & Regulations

1. Please note as this is a club fund raiser that involves a lot of work we ask visiting clubs or teams to support our event by not bringing their own meals or drinks, therefore **no esky's** we be allowed on the grounds unless for team water and game drinks purpose.
2. All team managers or coaches must register and attend the tournament briefing starting at 10:30am
3. All games will be consist of 2 x 10 min halves with a 2 min break between halves. (Horn will sound to indicate time changes and end of halves or games)
4. Games will be played on SSG size fields (50m x 30m)
5. FBI Rooball rules will apply for all general game rules for both age groups except: **5 players per team on the field at any given time** and **no players other than keeper allowed in the goal mouth semi circle.**
6. A 5 minute "Blue Card" rule will apply for all games in both age groups. If a player gets a second "Blue card" for a illegal foul or disciplinary reason in a game he will not be allowed back on the field for the rest of the game and the team will have to play one man short for the rest of the game. Depending on the nature or level of the offence committed by a player a disciplinary committee or tournament director has the right to ex-spell the player in question from the tournament.
7. Extra time will only be played in the sudden death stage of the carnival which will be 5 min per half. If no result during extra time a penalty shootout will take place. Each team must pick 5 players from their squad that played in the final to take the penalties, the goal keeper must be included. If still no result after penalties we will continue the shootout in a sudden death format.
8. The top 2 teams from each preliminary league pool will advance to the sudden death play-off finals. The winner of group A will play runner-up of group B and vice versa.
9. During the preliminary qualifying leagues 3 points will be awarded to the winning team and 1 points each in case of a draw. All 3 points will be awarded if a team has a bye.
10. In the event of a dead tie on points after the round robin stage the teams in question will be decided on goals for and if still no result then on goals against before advancing to the finals.
11. The carnival event referee will however be the final judge on any misunderstanding or decision.
12. The maximum numbers of players per team squad will be (8) players
13. **Please make note that only 5 players will be allowed including the goal keeper on the field at any given time during the games. Interchanges are unlimited.**
14. All referees will be supplied by Centenary Stormers Football club. At no stage will the referee will be subject to any verbal abuse or aggression.
15. No spectators will be allowed on the playing field during the game only the manager, coach or the first aid person on duty in the event of a injury during a match.
16. Team managers or coaches must collect their teams round robin draw when registering and will also receive their day planner or event time guidelines for the carnival.
17. All teams and clubs that sign our nomination form and enter this carnival will have read and abide by all these rules and regulations listed above in order to make this a successful fun filled family day for all.
18. Please provide a reliable mobile number for the team manager or coach on your nomination form so we can send you carnival updates and team information etc.. also in the event of rain we can text you on the condition of the grounds and whether or not the carnival will take place.
19. In the event of a rained out or cancelled event, the tournament will be rescheduled for another date.
